We've been in your shoes, navigating the complexities of leadership while lifting others up. Our programme draws on decades of experience, insights from the wāhine/women we've supported, and research on what drives leadership success.

Research shows that when wāhine/women step into leadership, businesses thrive. It proves diverse leadership <u>improves financial</u> <u>performance</u>, <u>fuels innovation and growth</u> and <u>strengthens organisational culture and</u> retention.





Our triple focus approach

Our **Emerging Women Leaders Programme** is designed to help wāhine/women break through the barriers holding them back by focusing on three key strategies:

- Mindset shift: We help wāhine/women recognise how their habits and mindset may be limiting their potential.
- **Practical growth:** Through evidence-based tools, one-on-one coaching, interactive workshops, and weekly leadership experiments, wāhine/women gain the confidence and skills to move forward as leaders.
- Supportive community: We create a psychologically safe space where wāhine/women can explore, experiment and flourish alongside like-minded peers.

Together, these build not just strong leaders, but lead to stronger teams and organisational culture.

Programme details

Duration: 9 months

Of guided, interactive learning mentoring, coaching, and group workshops

Cost: \$1875 (+gst) per person (paid in full) or 3 installments of \$687.50

Time Commitment:

- First four months: participants need to set aside approximately six hours per month for sessions, leadership experiments, and one-on-one coaching.
- Following five months: three hours per month
